Verse to Memorize:

Therefore, as God's chosen ones, holy and dearly loved, put on compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience, bearing with one another and forgiving one another if anyone has a grievance against another. Just as the Lord has forgiven you, so you are also to forgive. Above all, put on love, which is the perfect bond of unity.

Colossians 3:12-14

Key Takeaway:

This year we have learned about Jesus as King and the Kingdom that awaits us. In the book of Colossians, we will be looking at Paul's letter to the church in Colossae. This church is a lot like any church in the triangle- facing social pressure, cultural pressure, and the legalism of religion. This letter is simple. It teaches the church of Colossae (and our church now!) what it looks like to live as a citizen following Jesus as King.

How many pressures does your family face in a day? It is impossible to get it right on our own strength! The book of Colossians will walk us through the truth that, as citizens of the kingdom, our lives will always lean in on Jesus because of who he is. Throughout this study continuously point back to the truths you and your children learn about Jesus. This isn't a book of rules or must do's. It is a book that points us to the character of Jesus our King and in turn shows us to how our lives are changed because he is in them.
