#### Verse to Memorize:

I do not ask for these only, but also for those who will believe in me through their word, that they may all be one, just as you, Father, are in me, and I in you, that they also may be in us, so that the world may believe that you have sent me. The glory that you have given me I have given to them, that they may be one even as we are one, I in them and you in me, that they may become perfectly one, so that the world may know that you sent me and loved them even as you loved me.

#### Key Takeaway:

During this series your children will be learning about how the triune God-Father, Spirit, Son- exists in diversity and perfect oneness and unity and Jesus desires for his people to do the same. In John 17 we will see the heart of Jesus for his people as he prays for them. We will see his deep desire for Christian Unity and help us, and our kids, learn to look beyond ourselves and towards Divine Community.
